## The last meters - October

The last month before the Giant Jamboree still kept us busy with work! A few of our team members carried out some final experiments at a lab bench kindly provided by the Department of Biotechnology of BOKU. We were able to show that a fundamental component of our system can be installed with much less effort than we initially had thought; a vital information for future implementations of D.I.V.E.R.T.

By the end of October we submitted our parts to the standardized biological parts registy, survived the Wiki Freeze and filed our Judging Form to let the judges know for which categories we were applying in the competition.

We designed a poster to showcase our work at the Giant Jamboree poster session and came up with creative ideas on how to demonstrate our project concept to the audience in the final presentation.

## The Giant Jamboree 2017

Months of intensive and dedicated work as well as lots of fun lie behind us and we finally accomplished the ultimate goal: We arrived at the enormous Hynes Convention Center in Boston, together with 5400 other participants from 310 teams representing 44 countries.

We really enjoyed being part of this huge event – listening to several talks of other teams, doing some networking at the poster sessions and of course going to the official iGEM after-party to mingle with all the other iGEMers in an exciting entertainment complex. Bowling, a huge arcade gaming room and the Biota Beats official iGEM DJ comprised the perfect way to dissipate excess energy before the announcement of the competition's results on the final day!
